Dear Parents and Carers,

As an end-of-year trip, we are very excited to share with you that we have been able to arrange a visit to the Wildwood at Escot as part of a living history experience. The children will have the opportunity to experience what life was like for the Anglo Saxons, take part in a range of Anglo Saxon based activities and can get up close and personal with some native animals. This is a great way to celebrate the end of another school year and enjoy a day of fun and learning with each other. Dates:

Due to the venue being able to host a certain number of children per day we have split the trip across 2 days.

Monday 15th July – Dormice and Fox class

Tuesday 23rd July - Hedgehog and Owl class

On the day of the trip the children will need to be in school at 8:45am for a prompt departure at 9am. We will be departing the venue to return to school at 2.30pm so should arrive back to school at 3.30pm.

Children will need to be dressed in appropriate forest school clothing as children will be taking part in a range of activities in a wooded area. This needs to include a long-sleeved top, trousers and appropriate footwear such as old trainers or walking boots. All children should have suncream applied before they leave home and must bring a sunhat. All children should bring a rucksack which they are able to carry their water bottle and lunch in themselves. Dependent on the weather, children may need to bring a waterproof coat.

The school has subsidised the cost of the trip, so we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.00. This can be paid through school money or directly to the school office. If we do not receive enough contributions, this trip may have to be cancelled.

As always, we need volunteers to ensure we have appropriate numbers of adults to support our safeguarding requirements. If you are available on either of the dates and have a DBS certificate,
