Adverse Weather Conditions

Our children have been very excited about the snow this morning. I know parents and carers will be mindful of the possible impact of any adverse weather, especially as the snow is starting to settle. We will aim that school remains open unless there are safety concerns for children, staff or families. We always have to take into account staff having to travel long distances to get to and from work and ensuring it is safe for them to do so. Any decisions to close are taken in line with the Quantock Education Trust Adverse Weather policy.

- School has been salted by our staff to ensure that the grounds are as safe as possible but we advise everyone to take extra care and walk slowly around the grounds

- We have given safety talks to all the children this morning

We are not anticipating school closure, however, if this becomes necessary today or any other day, here is a reminder of how we would communicate this.

- Any school closure messages are made by our Facebook page, emails and texts to families. We would also post this on our website. Follow up phone calls would be made, during the day, if necessary

As an action of the risk assessment today, we have cancelled our After School Clubs, After School Care and Owl Class parents evening.

Please also be aware that the road to our parent and visitor car park is very slippery and we would advise all parents to walk if possible.
