English

The children will be focusing on the book 'Ten Little Pirates'. We will be using this book alongside many other authors to develop their discussion and story writing. We will also be writing reports linked to our science topic.

We will also be looking at lots of texts that link to our current topics across our wider curriculum subjects. E.g. Fossils (Geography/History), Plants (Science), etc. The children will use these texts to also produce some non-fiction writing.

Phonics/SPAG

Daily focussed phonic sessions will be used to continue to build the children's phonic knowledge. Spelling rules, punctuation and grammar skills will be imbedded daily as part of our English sessions. The children will have their Phonics Screening test after half term to test their phonic knowledge $(W/C 9^{th} June 2025).$

Fractions

- Recognising and finding halves.

- Describe turns left and right.
- Describe positions forwards, backwards, above and below.

Place Value to 100.

- Counting from 50 to 100 using tens and ones.

- Days of the week/months of the year/ hours, minutes and seconds.
- Tell the time to an hour and half an hour.

Number fluency will be practiced daily using a scheme called 'Mastering Numbers' to help increase children's recall speed.

We will be continuing with our topics of length and height, mass, capacity and temperature, position and direction.

History: Mary Anning

We will be exploring the significance of Mary Anning and why she was so important for the discovery of fossils.

Geography: Jurassic Coast

We will be exploring a local beach along the Jurassic coast and why it is special with a trip at the end of the term.

Art - 3D Flora and Fauna.

The children will be focusing on surface and colour, specifically focusing on exploring watercolour.

DT - Pirate Paddy's Packed Lunch

The children will be learning through food technology to create a packed lunch for Pirate Paddy.
