Y5/6 Girls – 4.50pm

Y5/6 Boys – 5.00pm

The Course:

The course will be one and a half laps of the top two playing fields. Y5/6s will do an extra lap of the top field. Please note, the start and finish are in different locations: The start will be on the further field with the finish closer to the main entrance.

Important - the start and finish are in different places so please make sure children are ready for their race at the start area. Please note the grass is a little long in places, particularly at the start.

Parking:

There is plenty of parking at the Football Club, mainly in the large car park behind the stadium. The main entrance from Lufton Way will be open. **IMPORTANT – there is a £3 charge payable by card or cash.**

Refreshments and Toilets:

The football club have kindly agreed to open the tea bar for us – please let parents and children know. The toilets behind the Away Stand will be open.

Behaviour and Safety:

Schools are responsible for the safety and behaviour of our own pupils. Please support us by reminding your child to be aware of the other races of runners, we must not obstruct or interfere with other runners.

Marshals:

Each school is asked, if possible, to provide a marshal for the races. If you are able to support please indicate this on the forms link.

Parents:

Adults are not allowed to run around the course to pace the children. In exceptional circumstances to help children having difficulties then adults with a school may run beside to encourage.

First Aid: A first aider from A2E Medical services will be in attendance.
