MATHS

Place value:

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 10,000 and determine the value of each digit.
- Count forwards or backwards in steps of power of 10.
- Count forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers including through zero.
- Round any number up to 100 000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10 000, and 100 000.
- Read Roman numerals to 1000 (M) and recognise years written in Roman numerals.

Addition and Subtraction:

- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in contexts.

Multiplication and division

- Identify multiples and factors.
- Multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a one or two -digit using long multiplication.
- I can multiply and divide numbers mentally drawing upon known facts.
- Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a one -digit number using short division.
- Multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.
- Recognise and use square numbers and cube numbers.
